UNMISS “Protection of Civilians” (PoC) Sites

As of 26 Sept 2019, a total of number of civilians seeking safety in six Protection of Civilians (PoC) sites located on UNMISS bases is **180,478** including 103,424 in Bentiu, 32,608 in Malakal, 29,436 in Juba UN House, 1,938 in Bor, and 13,072 in the area adjacent to UNMISS in Wau “.
