Duties and responsibilities:

Under the supervision of the Section Chief or his/her designate, the incumbent will be responsible for, but not limited to, the following functions:

- Skilfully operate various equipment such as the following –Bulldozer, Grader, Mobile Cranes, Fork-lifts ,Heavy Trucks and other Construction Equipment
- Loading, unloading and repositioning of Sea Containers, Engineering Equipment, land reform (Bulldozing and Compacting) in a safe manner;
- Assist with the deployment, assembly and disassembly of Accommodation Units throughout the Mission area;
- Conduct vehicle/equipment daily preventive maintenance checks as per requirements.
- Ensure that schedule maintenance and repairs are addressed to the relevant Transport Unit in a timely manner.
- Assist with the loading and unloading of equipment if same is to be transported to and from the work site.
- Should be prepared to be deployed on short or long term (reassignment) basis in any part of the Mission Area.(Sudan)
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Supervisor.

Qualifications and Experience:

- **Academic Backgrounds:** Completion of high school education.
- **Relevant working experiences:** A minimum of 3 years (three years) of consistent operation of Heavy Trucks, Forklifts and Engineering equipment.
- Knowledge of driving regulations and be capable of conducting minor vehicle/equipment repair.
- **Candidate must be in possession of a valid heavy duty driver's license reflecting the various categories.**

- Having a certificate or diploma on Operator Training in Engineering Equipment would be an asset.
- **Languages:** Must be able to communicate clearly in spoken and written Arabic and spoken English.
