## Duties and responsibilities:

Under the supervision of the Section Chief or his/her designate, the incumbent will be responsible for, but not limited to, the following functions:

- Dismantle and assemble damaged/repaired vehicle body panels, repair panels to the original shape and dimensions effectively.
- Repair vehicle body panels (Panel-beat) and apply the necessary body fillers/ coatings to the vehicle body parts to bring them to original shape.
- Spray-paint vehicle body panels to original colors by determining the correct mix for different types of vehicle paints.
- Undertake sign-writing on vehicles bodies, design and write vehicle number plates to meet the transport requirements.
- Perform other duties as directed by the Supervisor.


## Qualifications and Experiences:

- Academic Backgrounds: High school diploma or equivalent. Technician College qualifications as Motor vehicle Technician (National Certificate or equivalent) on Vehicle Body repairs. Must have a valid driving license. Having a heavy duty driving license would be desirable.
- Relevant working experience: At least three (3) years of relevant postapprenticeship/work experience. Must possess a sound knowledge of Vehicle Body repair works (Panel Beating) and spray painting etc. Must be familiar with the guidelines and procedures relative to the safe operations of workshop equipment such as vehicle body jacks, engine hoist and various other electrical, pneumatics and hydraulic equipment.
- Language: Fluency in written/spoken English and Arabic with good communication skills.
