

**QIPs approved during the year 2013-14**

1	Health	Marjayoun, SE	The purpose of the project was to provide ICU Medical equipment, specifically Syringe pumps, ECG machines and ventilators to be used in the ICU of the hospital. The project is closed and has been inaugurated.
2	Health	Kfarhammam, SE	This project was about upgrading the capacity of Kfarhammam public dispensary by adding additional consultation rooms, one bathroom, one reception area, a space for medicines storage and additional stairs leading to the roof. The project is closed and has been inaugurated.
3	Health	Adshit al Qusayr, SE	This project was about establishing new clinic where medical and dental care could be provided not only to the residents of the village but also to people living in neighbouring villages. The project is closed and has been inaugurated.
4	Environment	Kawkaba, SE	The purpose of the project was to procure a dump truck for the Municipality to enable it to properly collect garbage dumped at unauthorized locations, and transport it to the designated dump at the outskirts of the village. The project is closed and has been inaugurated.
5	Environment	Naqoura, SW	This project sought to connect 230 households in Naqoura to the new sewage treatment plant in UNIFIL Hqrs. By sharing its resources with its neighbouring community, and offering a sustainable solution to the sewage problem, UNIFIL will support the town's sewage management plan and also contribute to conserving the town's environment and fresh water resources in line with UNIFIL's adopted policies inside its camps. The project is closed and has been inaugurated.
6	Environment	Dayr Ntar, SW	This project will provide internal sewage network to one of the town's quarter, which will benefit about 3000 residents. The environmental advantages are tremendous, because individual sanitation pits will no longer be used. This Municipality has not received much assistance from UNIFIL till date.
7	Water	Baraashit, SW	This project aims at providing the residents of Baraashit and nearby villages better access to collected rainwater by rehabilitating the existing pond. The water collected would help in irrigating fields, plantations and also benefit other animal herders, thereby having a positive impact on the whole community.
8	Water	Dayr Qanun Ras Al Ayn, SW	This project is about building a water passage that would enable residents of Dayr Qanun R'as al Ayn to use the road that connects this village with the villages of Al Knaysah, Al Malikiyah and Ash Sh'aytiyah without being hindered by water running through the road. By having this water passage, the residents will also enjoy quick and unhindered access to other far off villages such as Qana and others. The project is closed.
9	Water	El Meri	The project consists of building a water tank with a capacity of 90m3 in El Meri. The water tower is located near an artificial water borehole already equipped with a submersible pump,

			pipes and permanent government power. The water tower will supply El Meri and the neighbouring villages with potable water during the dry season, especially when water levels decrease.
10	Water	Marun ar R'as, SW	This project is about establishing water connections which would lead to the rain water collection pond already been used by the village.
11	Water	Bint Jubayl Union of Municipalities, SW	This project is about raising awareness on water conservation and water management for targeted stakeholders so that they can take steps to increase water supply and better manage its distribution in their respective areas.
12	Power	Qana, SW	The purpose of the project was to procure 20 street lamps that will be installed on the main roads of Qana, to help the Municipality provide better security to its residents. The project is closed.
13	Power	Khiam, SE	This project is about providing 320 street LED lights to the Municipality which will benefit more than 15000 of its inhabitants.
14	Education/Capacity building	Ma'rakah, SW	The project seeks to equip the Ma'rakah Public Technical Academy with an electronic laboratory which would facilitate the students of the electronic major in the academy to have a practical education component that complements their theoretical education.
15	Education/Capacity building	Burj Rahhal, Dayr Qanun, Abbasiyah, SW	This projects aims at building capacities of 3 rural women agricultural and handicraft cooperatives through training on food processing and other marketing strategies/tools. The training workshops will enable the cooperatives to reach out to distant markets.
16	Education/Capacity building	Ma'rakah, SW	This project is about conducting a workshop/training on agricultural practices/irrigation/fertilization and processing of food products to 50 farmers and 45 women of Ma'rakah.
17	Education/Capacity building	Ramyah, SW	This project is about carrying out capacity building for 50 women by teaching them sewing/knitting/crochet work and also conducting a workshop on processing of agricultural food products.
18	Roads	Markaba, SE	This project involves marking the sides of the road with hot thermoplastic paint and with reflective glass beads, as well as installing cat eyes.
19	Social	As Sultaniyah, SW	The purpose of the project is to rehabilitate the village's public cemetery that is severely eroded in parts. The project is closed and has been inaugurated.
20	Social	Tallusah, SE	The purpose of the project was to enable the Municipality to have a fully equipped public space where they can hold cultural, educational and social activities for the benefit of their residents. The project is closed and has been inaugurated.
21	Social	Ebel el Saqi, SE	Project consisted of rehabilitating the social hall attached to the Ebel el Saqi natural reserve. Rehabilitating this hall would now enable the municipality to hold social, cultural and recreational events. Also provide additional support to the natural reserve. The project is closed and has been inaugurated.
22	Social	Bani Hayyan, SE	This project involved providing the new two-storey building (municipality and public clinic) with the necessary furniture and

			equipment to be fully operational by early 2014. The project was about improving capacity of the municipality to better serve the residents of the municipality. The project is closed and has been inaugurated.
23	Others	Rshaf, SW	The project was about Installing fiber cement roofing canopy over the football pitch. The works relating to construction of concrete foundations, installation of metal bridges etc, were paid for by the Municipality. The project is closed and has been inaugurated.
24	Others	Yaroun, SW	This project is about repairing the canopy for the football pitch which was destroyed in a storm in December 2013.
25	Others	Mazra'at Mushrif, SW	This project is about providing a mini-football pitch in the Municipality.
