UNMISS “Protection of Civilians” (PoC) Sites Population Update*

As of 16 January 2020, the total number of civilians seeking safety in six Protection of Civilians (PoC) sites located on UNMISS bases is **189,762**. This includes 117,767 in Bentiu, 27,924 in Malakal, 29,476 in Juba UN House, 1,931 in Bor, and 12,664 in the area adjacent to UNMISS in Wau.
